**Concept Note**

The study of Social Sciences in recent years is moving from a specialized to an integrated approach. The teaching and learning experiences in social sciences at present focus on the active creation of knowledge by students through their experiences and social engagement. For a transformative educational experience students require multidisciplinary approaches in pedagogy to enhance their interpersonal skill sets, empathy, and marketability as “future professionals and engaged citizens” (Herremans & Murch 2003; Lam, Kolomitro and Alamparambil, 2011). The constructivist method places a focus on the active creation of knowledge by students through their experiences and social engagement. The reflective method encourages self-awareness. The integrative approach integrates several fields of study and viewpoints. While the inquiry-based method encourages students to become active citizens. Keeping in mind the interpretation of the output of research, it is needed to explore the complex ramifications of approaches as Derrida has shown, meaning does not reside in the text but in the writing and reading of it (Hodder, 1994).

### Objectives of the Seminar:

- This seminar will try to explore the multiple interpretations beyond sullen acceptance of impositions in social science pedagogy and research to facilitate the breeding of accomplished and bold social scientists.
- This seminar will enhance the intellectual acumen of the teachers as well as the students.

Interested scholars are required to send their full-length papers (3000-5000 words) in MS Word format following MLA Handbook 9/e, Text: English, Times New Roman, Font: 12, Line: 1.5 spaces, Left Alignment and 1.5 inch margin on all sides. Footnotes are to be avoided. Endnotes, if required, may be incorporated. The paper must also include bio-note of the author(s) with passport sized photograph(s), e-mail ID, whatsapp number, institutional affiliation details (if any) and certification of anti-plagiarism.

If the paper is in Bengali we recommend the use of Avro Keyboard and Font: 14. Rest of the stipulations are same as mentioned above.
