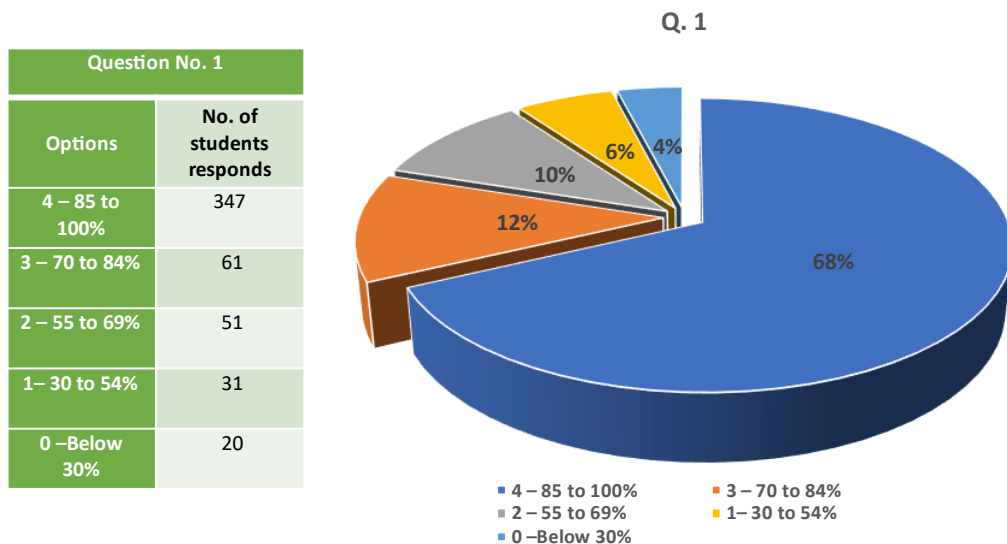

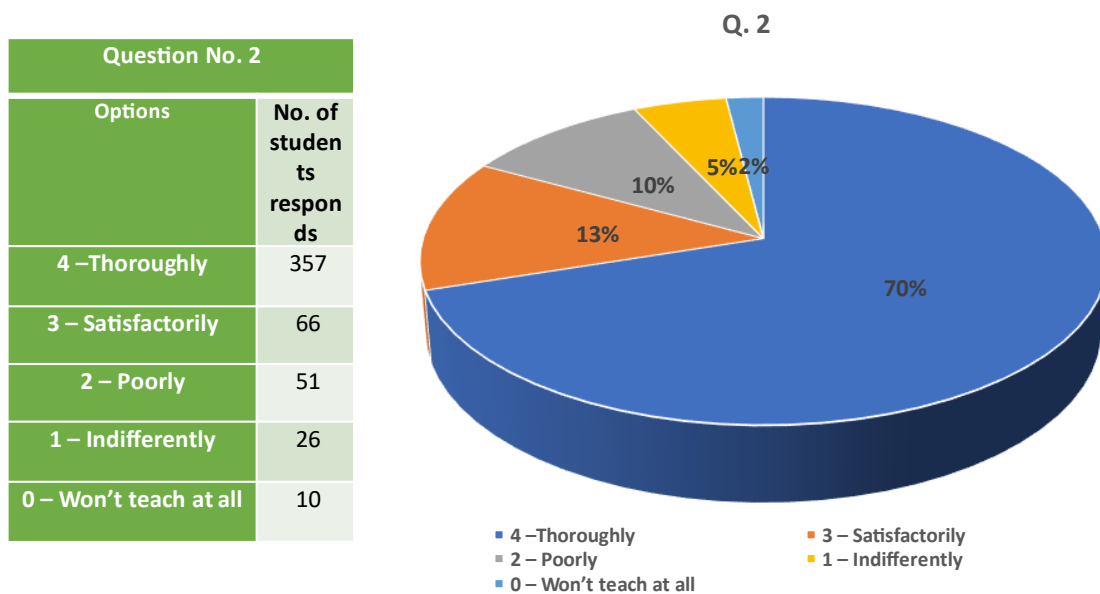

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

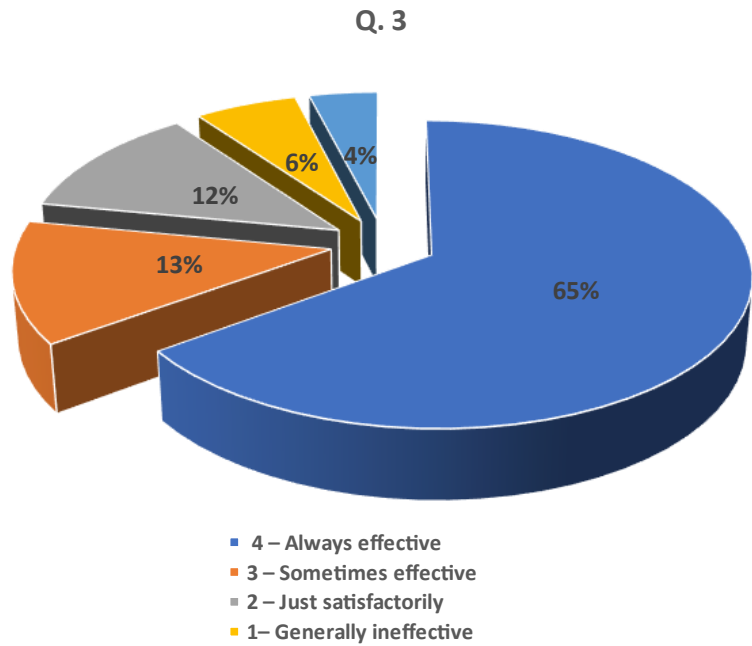


2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



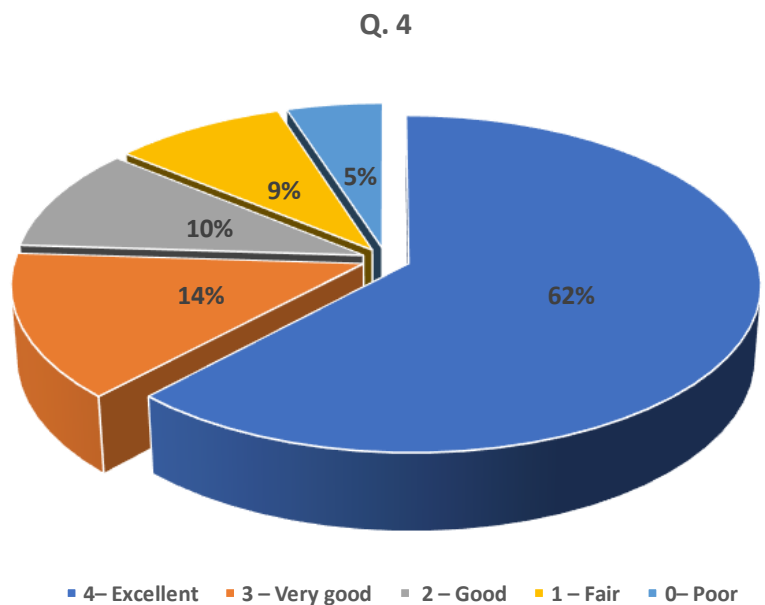
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

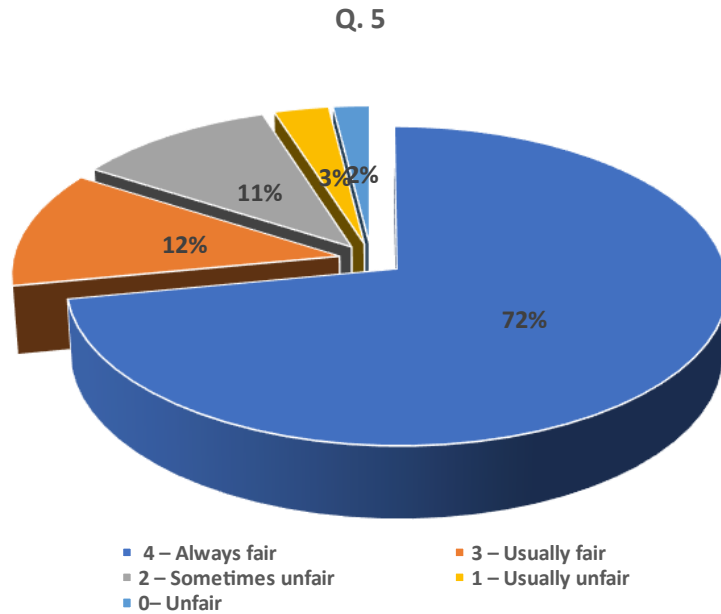

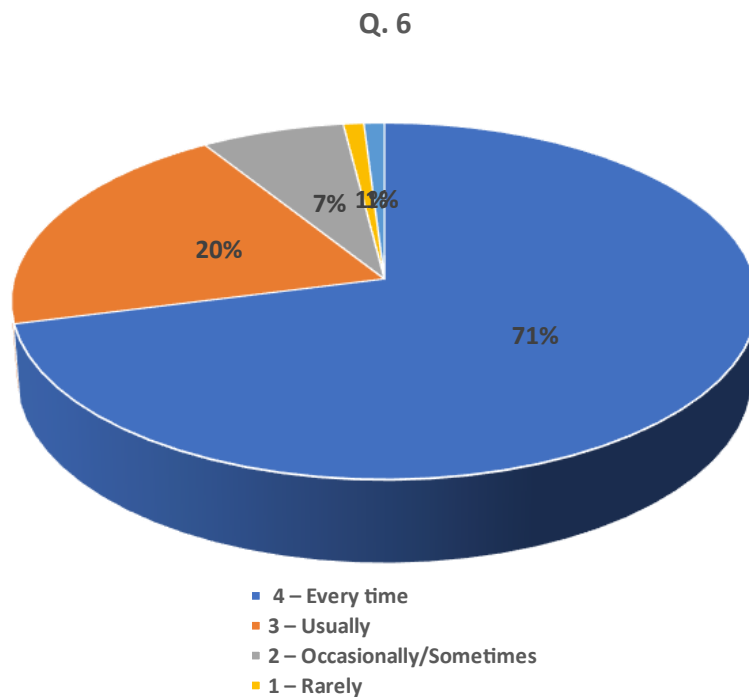

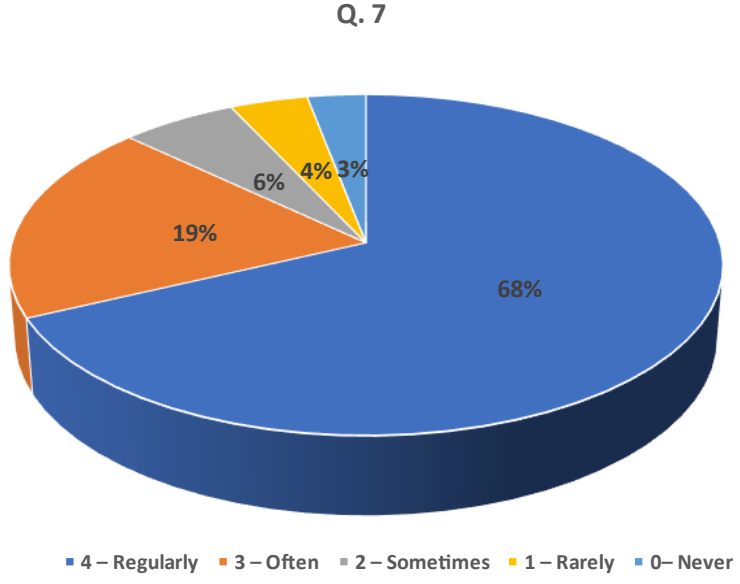

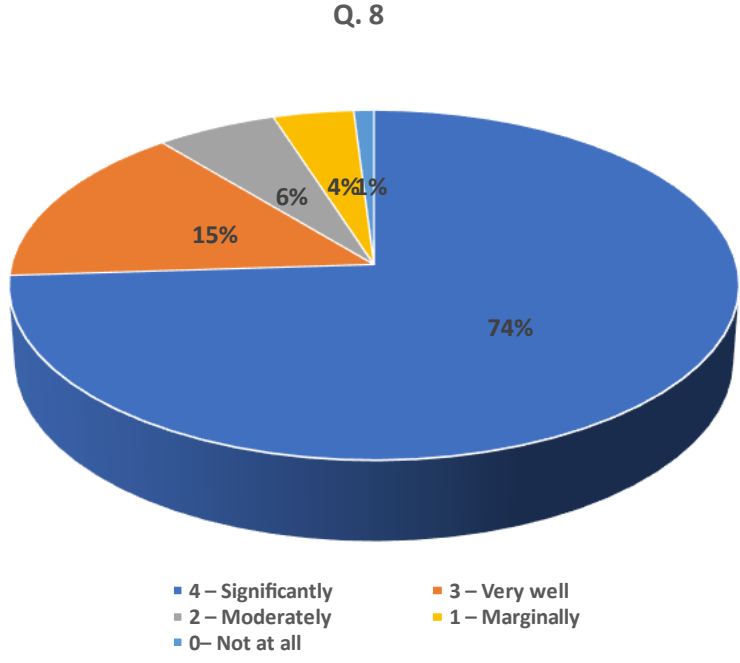

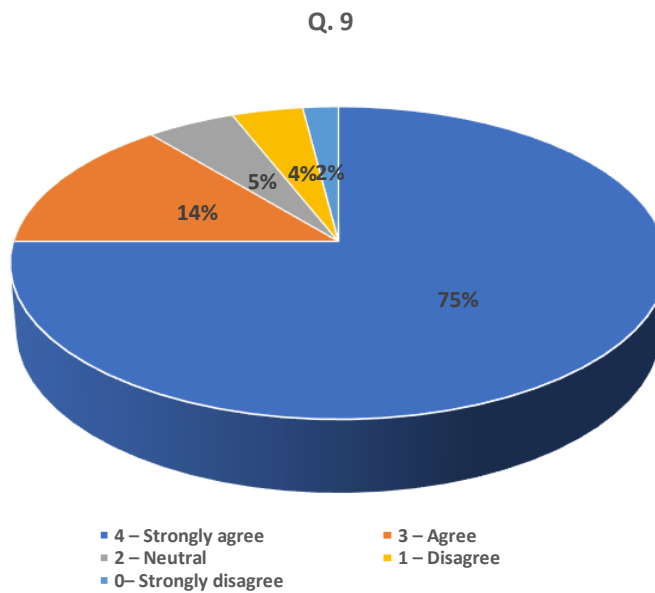

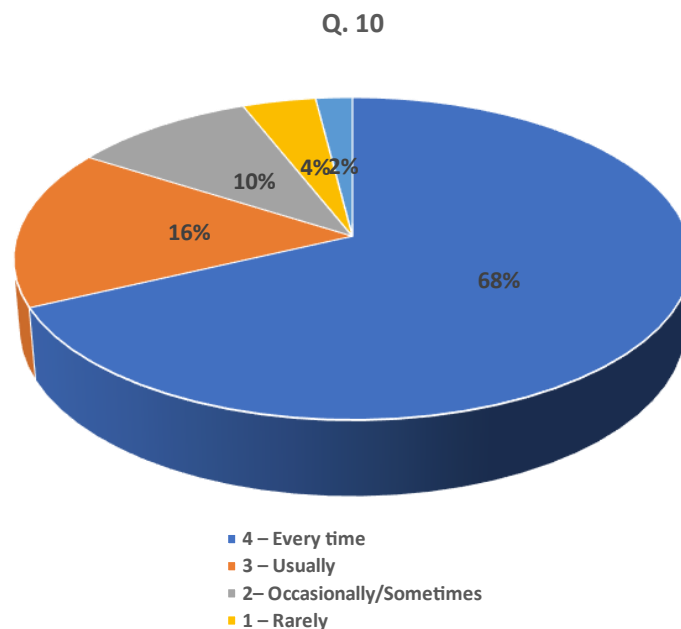

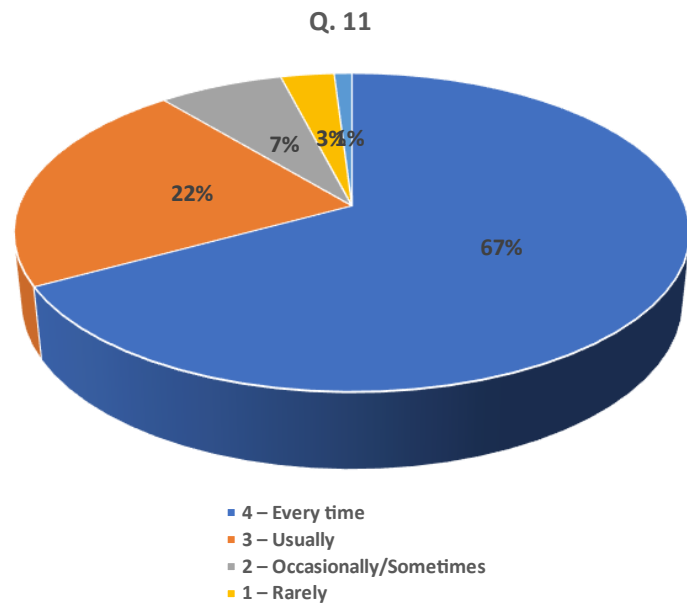

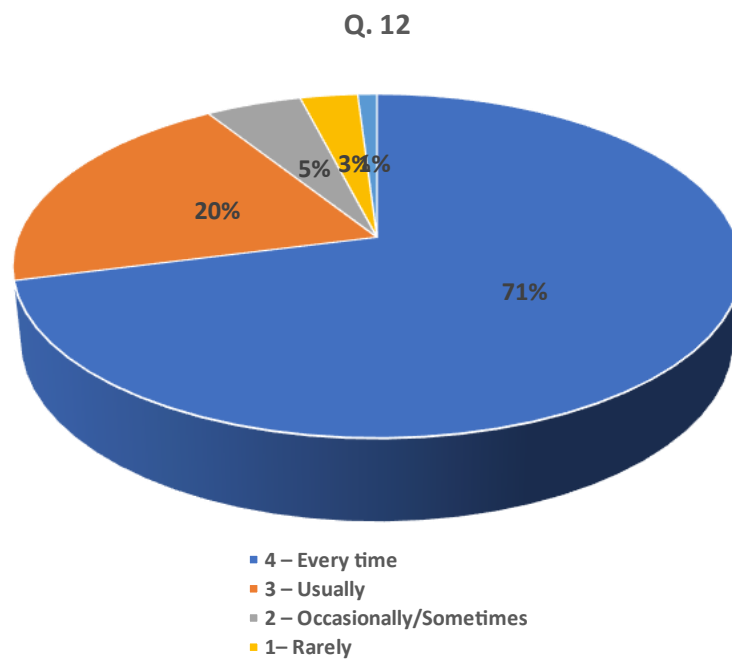

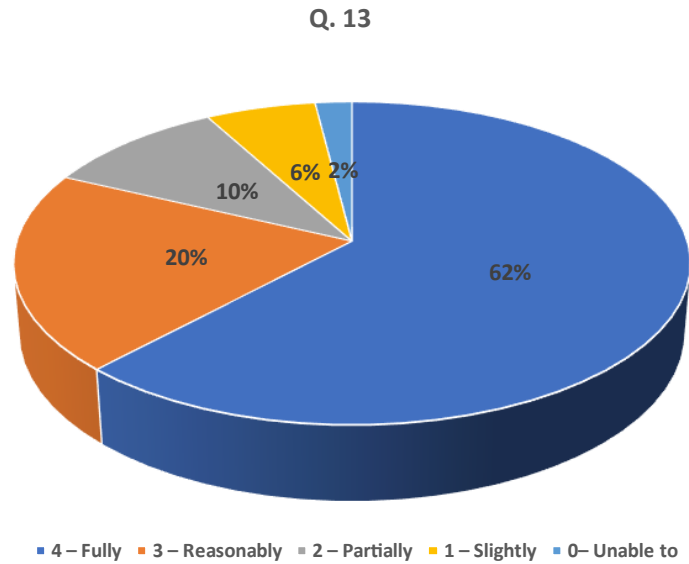

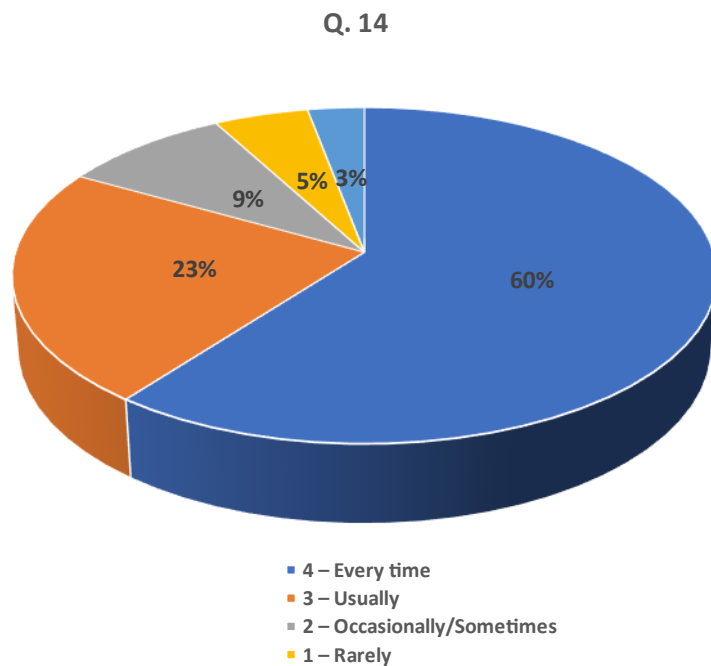

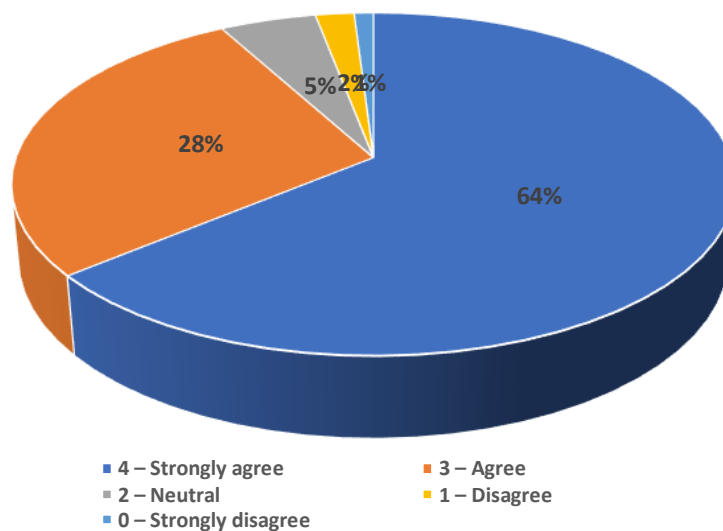

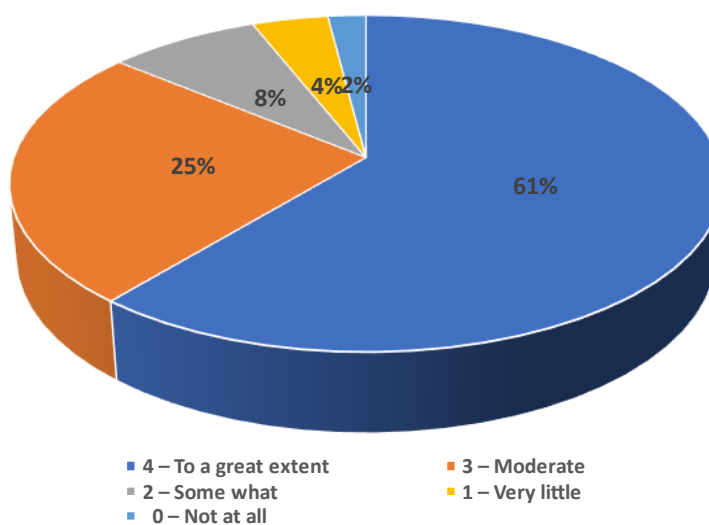

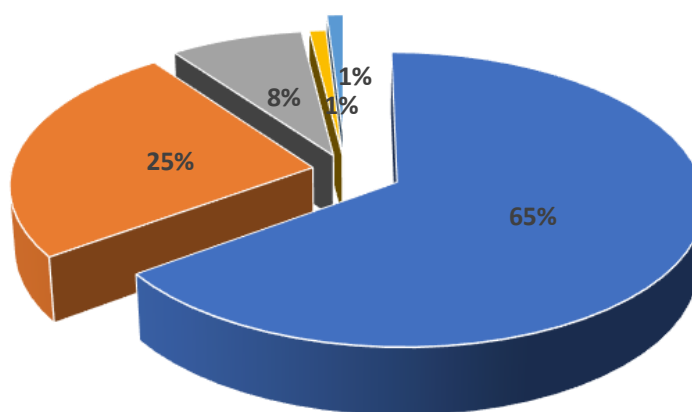

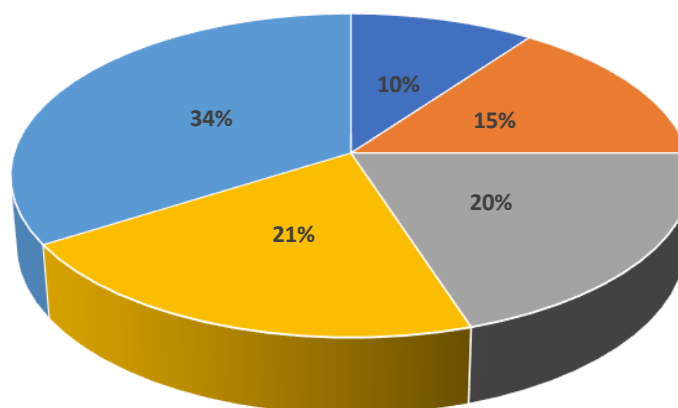

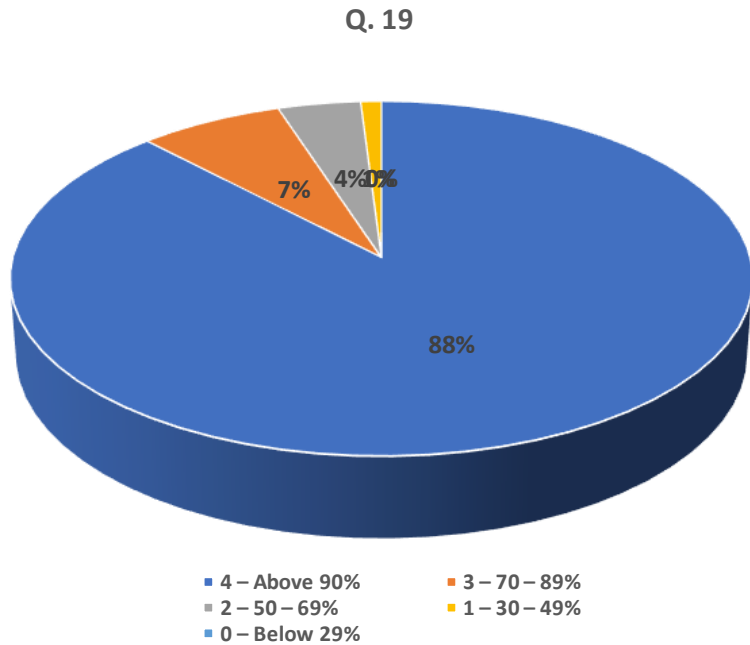
