Annual Report of Jangipur College in Respect of Quality Initiatives 2023-24

1. Initiatives:

- a. In 2022-23 NEP 2020 was introduced in the college and this was backed by a day-long workshop- NEP: An Overview in which the dignitaries from the affiliating University including the Controller of Examinations, were present.
- b. 07 workshops, 07 seminars, 02 invited talks and 02 extension lectures were organized to include expansive teaching-learning, sensitization on gender and positive discrimination and introduction of patents and IPR. IQAC has undertaken initiatives to form an IPR Club in the college as well.
- c. Staff benefit initiatives included accomplishment of CAS of 06 teachers and disbursal of Rs 2892000.00 as loan from Provident Fund.
- d. To benefit the students apart from implementing the various scholarship schemes of the Government of West Bengal, the institution subscribes to Students' Health Home Scheme. Off-campus placement of TCS-BPS on 22.08.23, 04 students got jobs and through on-campus TCS-BPS Recruitment Drive on 06.03.24, 42 students secured placements. To ensure success in such drives IQAC along with the Career Counselling Cell organized several training sessions in both online and offline modes.
- e. Regarding mobilization of funds for research a sum of Rs 947000.00 (ICSSR-MRP) and Rs 2147020.00 (DST-SERB) were obtained by two Assistant Professors of the college. The NSS also received Rs 71000.00 to conduct activities involving the local community.
- f. Under the aegis of the IQAC, the Women's Cell organized Pakhwada from 25th November 2023 to 10th December 2023. Along with this, 05 sensitization programs were organized which involved resource persons from India and abroad. The Women's Cell also conducted a Gender Audit: 2023-24 to take account of both the academic and socio-economic status of the girl students studying in this institution.
- g. The Equal Opportunity Centre of the college organized a 03 Days' Workshop on Positive Discrimination from 22.02.24 to 24.02.24 involving resource persons of national repute and faculty members of the college.
- h. 06 MoUs were signed involving well-reputed educational institutions and 01 MoU was done to facilitate e-waste management system of the college.
- i. The Research Cell was boosted through the introduction of college-sponsored research projects. In 2023-24, 01 faculty member from the Department of Zoology benefitted from this scheme and received a sum of Rs 10000.00 to conduct a project involving an Assistant Professor from the Indian Statistical Institute and the students of the Zoology department, Jangipur College.
- j. Quality initiatives of IQAC involve upgradation and sustenance of existing infrastructure through auditing processes. Accordingly, auditing in terms of EMS (ISO 14001:2015) and QMS (ISO 9001:2015) by IAF enlisted organization was conducted.
- k. Since the Government of West Bengal is yet to assign a statutory auditor, IQAC ensured that the accounts of the college be audited by a distinguished auditing firm.
